

Engineering Class of 1983 Scholarship

In 2018, several alumni from the Engineering Class of 1983 initiated a fundraising effort to raise an endowed sum of S\$150,000 from their class to support a scholarship.

The bond-free scholarship of S\$8,000 per annum is awarded to deserving students for their normal course duration. This scholarship is **by invitation only**. Shortlisted students will be invited to submit the necessary documentation and may be required to attend an interview.

Selection Criteria

The applicant should:

- 1. Be a Singapore citizen or permanent resident.
- 2. Be a full-time engineering undergraduate in his/her first year of study (i.e., matriculation year).
- 3. Possess outstanding Singapore-Cambridge GCE A Level, local polytechnic diploma, International Baccalaureate diploma, NUS High School diploma or equivalent qualification. Participation in extra-curricular activities or community service will be considered favourably.
- 4. Should not be a concurrent recipient of any other form of aid such as grants, bursaries and scholarships.
- 5. Have a per capita income (PCI) ≤ 1000.
- 6. Have submitted an online financial aid application at the <u>Undergraduate Financial Aid</u> Portal along with (hard copy) supporting documents to the <u>Office of Financial Aid</u>.

Scholarship recipients need to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.50 and above in each academic year to continue receiving the scholarship.
