### SHORT BIOGRAPHY

François Decoster (1966) is a French architect and urbanist. He graduated from the School of Architecture of Versailles in 1993 and from the Institute of Political Sciences of Paris in 1995.

He was a founding member of *Dynamiques Urbaines* a research and consultancy programme on the cities of Hanoi and Hué in Vietnam in 1995-1996.

He has worked on urban studies at RATP, the Parisian public transport company, in 1995, and at SCET Ile-de-France, a French national public developer, in 1995-1996.

In 1996, with Djamel Klouche and Caroline Poulin, he founded l'AUC, an architecture, urbanism, research, urban and public space design office based in Paris.

l'AUC is laureate of the European V competition (1999), laureate of the Nouveaux Albums de la Jeune Architecture (2001-2002), laureate of the Palmarès des Jeunes Urbanistes (2005).

l'AUC was awarded the Grand Prix de l'Urbanisme by an international jury gathered by the french Ministry of Ecological Transition and Territorial Cohesion in charge of urbanism, housing, construction and city politics, in 2021.

l'AUC was awarded the Patrick Abercrombie Prize for architecture and urbanism by the International Union of Architects (UIA) in 2023.

François Decoster teaches urbanism and urban design at the National University of Singapore, College of Design and Engineering (previously School of Design and Environment), Department of Architecture, Master of Urban Design, since 2003. He regularly participates and lectures in schools, institutions, talks, interviews and conferences related to planning, urban design and urbanism.
