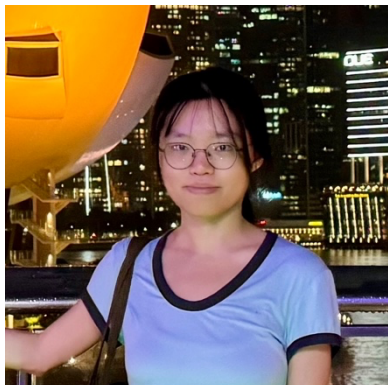


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RESEARCH AREA: urban planning, transportation governance



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Yufei Wang is a PhD candidate in the Department of Architecture at the National University of Singapore. She holds an MPhil in Urban Governance and Design from the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (Guangzhou), an MRes in Urban Research with Distinction from the University of Glasgow, UK, and a Bachelor of Engineering in Urban and Rural Planning from South China University of Technology, China. Her research focuses on transportation governance, with particular attention to how governance actors and institutional arrangements shape the planning and implementation of transportation decarbonization policy.

Her dissertation examines the evolution of street transformation, the policies and initiatives that reconfigure urban streets through redesign, space reallocation, and traffic regulation, in London, San Francisco, and Singapore through historical and comparative analysis across urban and neighborhood scales. In addition to her dissertation research, she also contributes to research projects focused on vehicle electrification, transportation decarbonization, and transit-oriented neighborhoods.

Yufei is experienced in mixed-methods research, combining quantitative text analysis and statistical methods with qualitative approaches, including document analysis, thematic analysis, and qualitative comparative analysis (QCA).
