## NUS CDE Career Fair – Event Details

### 1. Can I participate in both the days or any day of the NUS CDE Career Fair 2023 upon registration?

Please register your interest on [NUS TalentConnect](#) before 13 September 2023. You are eligible to join both the days of the CDE Career Fair, or any day of the event once registered.

### 2. What is the maximum student capacity for each session of the NUS CDE Career Fair 2023?

Due to space constraints, limited slots are allowed to participate. Therefore, we encourage students to register early to avoid disappointment.

### 3. What time will the NUS CDE Career Fair 2023 start and end on both days?

The event will start at 10am daily. The event venue will open 15 mins before the start of each day.

### 4. What do I need to prepare to enter the NUS CDE Career Fair 2023?

Please bring along your Confirmation Email (softcopy/hardcopy). Students Participants are required to get ready your uNivUS App and show your eCard on the App for onsite check-in. Student Participants may require to perform any additional onsite registration or safe entry, per latest guideline by NUS Office of Risk Management and Compliance (ORMC) on NUS Safe Management Measures (SMMs).

Please note that only pre-registered and pre-approved Student Participants will be allowed in.



### 5. Is there any dress code for NUS CDE Career Fair 2023?

Yes, the event dress code will be **business casual**. Tank tops, sports attire, bermudas and slippers are **strictly not allowed**. Remember, you are here to meet your potential employers!

Organizers may turn away students who do not meet the event dress code.
