

Chin Peng Lim and Chin Kim Choo Scholarship

In 2020, Mr Chin Thoe Chong made an endowed gift of S\$150,000 to the School of Design and Environment (now College of Design and Engineering) to support a scholarship in memory of his late parents, Mr Chin Peng Lim and Mrs Chin Kim Choo.

The bond-free scholarship of up to S\$9,200 per annum (subject to the availability of the distributable return from the capital sum) is awarded to a deserving student for his/her normal course duration. This scholarship is **by invitation only**. Shortlisted students will be invited to submit the necessary documentation and may be required to attend an interview.

Selection Criteria

The applicant should:

1. Be an international or Singapore Permanent Resident from Malaysia.
2. Be pursuing a first degree at the College of Design and Engineering in Architecture or Infrastructure and Project Management or Landscape Architecture or Industrial Design.
3. Possess outstanding Singapore-Cambridge GCE A Level, local polytechnic diploma, International Baccalaureate diploma, NUS High School diploma or equivalent qualification.
4. Not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance, without prior written approval from NUS.
5. Be actively involved in Co-Curricular activities (CCA) and have strong commitment in serving school/institution, community and/or society.
6. Demonstrate the spirit of Innovation & Enterprise through CCA or community work.
7. Display exemplary conduct and serve as role models for their peers.

While there is no bond attached to the Chin Peng Lim and Chin Kim Choo Scholarship, students are required to take up the MOE Tuition Grant to receive the scholarship. Singapore Permanent Residents and international students who take up the MOE Tuition Grant will be bonded under the terms of the Tuition Grant – to work for a Singapore-registered company for three years immediately after graduation.

Scholarship recipients need to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.50 and above in each academic year to continue receiving the scholarship.
