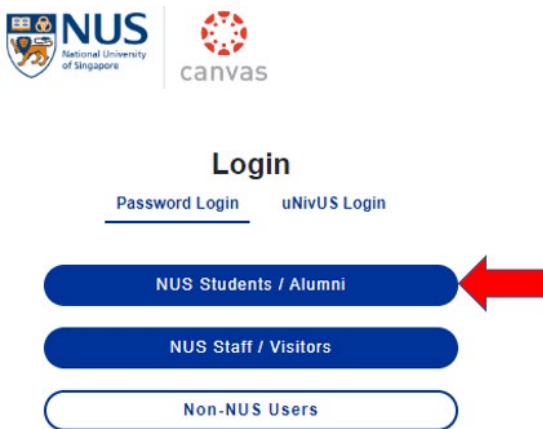


Accessing Course Resources on Canvas

Canvas is the web-based Learning Management System (LMS) adopted by NUS to support teaching and learning. Through Canvas, you can access course materials, submit assignments, participate in discussions, and track your academic progress—all in one place.

How to Access Your Courses

1. Go to Canvas
 - Open your browser and visit <https://canvas.nus.edu.sg>.
2. Log In
 - Click on **NUS Students/Alumni**.

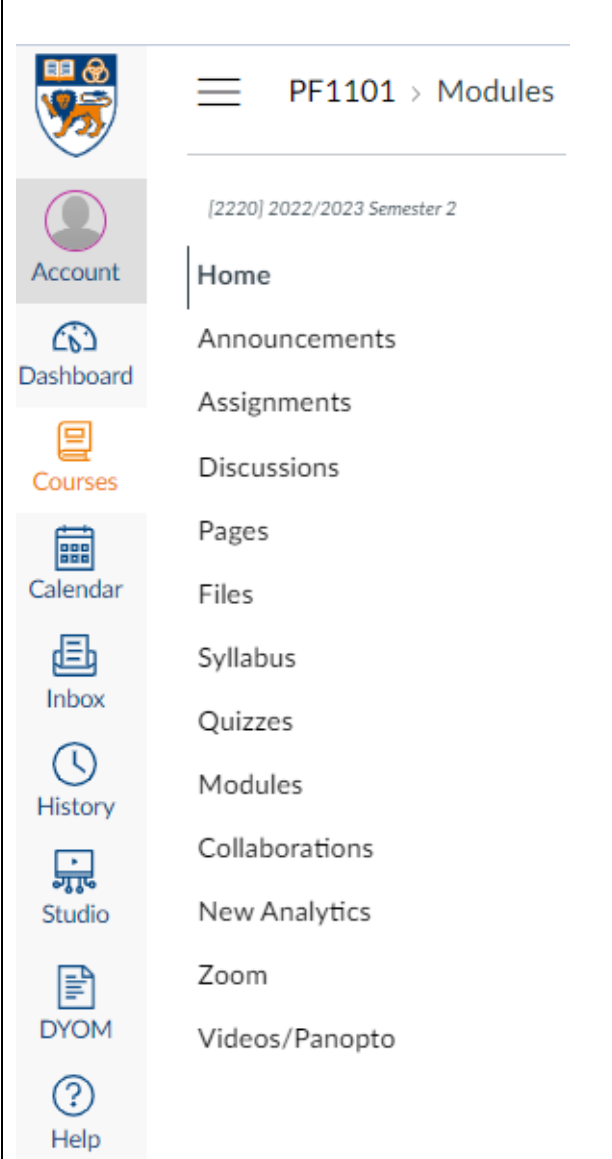
