Application Process

Interested candidates can apply for Semester I (August) each academic year. We welcome applicants from diverse backgrounds who are dynamic and collaborative.



Application Fee

All applicants must pay a SGD\$150 non-refundable application fee (not inclusive prevailing GST) online.

Admission Requirements

Prospective students should have a Bachelor's Degree with merit or second class honours, in a relevant design discipline.

Candidates must also provide

1. Detailed CV & examples of previous work
2. Video Submission (5 mins video)

The above are minimum requirements which do not guarantee admission. Selection of candidates for admission is on a competitive basis.

English Language Requirements

To meet the English requirement for our Masters by coursework programmes, the minimum score expected is :

85 (for TOEFL iBT®) or 6.0 (for IELTS/Academic)
