

Engineering Class of 1983 Scholarship

In 2018, several alumni from the Engineering Class of 1983 initiated a fundraising effort to raise an endowed sum of S\$150,000 from their class to support a scholarship.

The bond-free scholarship of up to S\$9,000 per annum (subject to the availability of the distributable return from the capital sum) is awarded to deserving students for their normal course duration. This scholarship is **by invitation only**. Shortlisted students will be invited to submit the necessary documentation and may be required to attend an interview.

Selection Criteria

The applicant should:

1. Be a Singapore citizen or permanent resident.
2. Be a full-time engineering undergraduate in his/her first year of study (i.e., matriculation year).
3. Possess outstanding Singapore-Cambridge GCE A Level, local polytechnic diploma, International Baccalaureate diploma, NUS High School diploma or equivalent qualification. Participation in extra-curricular activities or community service will be considered favourably.
4. Not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance, without prior written approval from NUS.
5. Requires financial support and has submitted an online [Financial Aid Application](#) to Office of Financial Aid and uploaded the relevant supporting documents via the Undergraduate Financial Aid Portal within two weeks of the online application.

While there is no bond attached to the Engineering Class of 1983 Scholarship, students are required to take up the MOE Tuition Grant to receive the scholarship. Singapore Permanent Residents and international students who take up the MOE Tuition Grant will be bonded under the terms of the Tuition Grant – to work for a Singapore-registered company for three years immediately after graduation.

Scholarship recipients need to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.50 and above in each academic year to continue receiving the scholarship.
