

Micron Scholarship

In 2010, Micron made a gift of US\$250,000 for the purpose of establishing an endowed scholarship for full-time first year undergraduates. Students from the following engineering departments will be considered for the scholarship with one student selected from each department in each consecutive academic year:

- Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering
- Industrial Systems Engineering and Management
- Electrical and Computer Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering
- Materials Science and Engineering

The bond-free scholarship of up to S\$10,750 per annum (subject to the availability of the distributable return from the capital sum) is awarded to one deserving first-year student per year for four consecutive years of study. This scholarship is **by invitation only**. Shortlisted students will be invited to submit the necessary documentation and may be required to attend an interview.

Selection Criteria

The applicant should:

1. Be a Year 1 student.
2. Not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance, without prior written approval from NUS.

While there is no bond attached to the Micron Scholarship, students are required to take up the MOE Tuition Grant to receive the scholarship. Singapore Permanent Residents and international students who take up the MOE Tuition Grant will be bonded under the terms of the Tuition Grant – to work for a Singapore-registered company for three years immediately after graduation.

Scholarship recipients need to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.50 and above in each academic year to continue to receive the scholarship.
